



ADULT SPORTS PLAYER/TEAM CONDUCT

NO SMOKING OR PROFANITY:

Player, coaches and managers will not be permitted to smoke on the coaching lines, dugout or playing field. The use of loud and obvious profanity will also not be tolerated. If a player on the field/court is heard yelling profanity the following actions will be taken:

- A. Player receives verbal warning.
- B. Player is removed from game.
- C. An official or FVPD employee is empowered to eject any player that flagrantly ignores warnings about their use of offensive language.

NO DRINKING OF ALCHOLIC BEVERAGES ON OR AROUND THE FVPD FACILITIES BEFORE, DURING OR AFTER A GAME. Managers will be held responsible for their teams, so please notify all members of you teams and their followers of this rule. Please keep our diamonds and parks free of cans and bottles.

- A. Violations will result in one game team forfeiture and one game suspension of individuals.
- B. Repeated violations will result in the team's expulsion from the league.

UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT:

A. Any player or coach ejected from the game by an official for unsportsmanlike conduct shall automatically be suspended for the next five (5) games. In the event a player or coach deviates from this ruling, it will constitute a forfeit and the team not at fault will receive credit for a win.

B. Any player(s) or coaches ejected from the game by an official for fighting will automatically be suspended for the next fifteen (15) games. In the event of a player or coach deviating from this ruling, it will constitute a forfeit and the team not at fault will receive credit for a win.

C. If ejected from a game, this means that this player is not allowed to participate in ANY games during that time of suspension.

D. A player who is suspended is not allowed on ANY FVPD softball facilities during the time of suspension. A player may be suspended for a longer period of time by the Athletic Director if this behavior is considered serious. A player receiving two (2) suspensions in one (1) season will be suspended for the remainder of the season. Any player who plays while under suspension will be eliminated from further play for a period of (1) year, and his/her team will forfeit each game which he/she played under suspension. Suspensions for a specific number of games begin with and include only played games and will overlap into the following season when needed.

E. Any player, or spectator; who is guilty of striking an official or staff member in any manner during or after a game shall automatically be suspended indefinitely from participating in ALL leagues sponsored by the Recreation Department.

F. All regulations apply to spectators and it is up to team manager to inform each individual of above statements.
